Eric Radford is a two-time World champion (2015, 2016), a 2014-2018 Olympic silver and gold medalist in the team event, a 2018 Olympic bronze medalist in the pairs event, a two-time Four Continents champion (2013,2015), the 2014-2015 Grand Prix Final champion, and a seven-time Canadian national champion (2012-18). Eric retired from competition in April 2018 adjusting his career to exhibitions, coaching and choreography.

Luis Fenero is a Spanish ice dancer who competed in the final segment at two ISU Championships - 2013 Junior Worlds in Milan, Italy; and 2016 Europeans in Bratislava, Slovakia.
